Minutes of South Toledo Bend Water Board January 12, 2015

Meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM by Malcolm Franks. The roll was called and, an opening prayer was said by Malcolm Franks.

Board President Malcolm Franks gave an update on the road bore project stating that contractor is having to wait on the water level to get lower to perform the boring. An update was also given on Project FP&C 50-NCN-10-01, auto read water meters. Contractor has installed all meters required per contract. A certificate of substantial completion has been signed and a final request for funds are to be submitted.

- For the, month of November the plant processed <u>6483000</u> gallons of water at an average of <u>209129</u> GPD and shipped out <u>6420127</u> gallons of water at an average of 207000 gallons per day.
- Plant usage for production (chlorine, caustic, & polymer carrier waters) estimated at 50,000 gallons. Plant usage for backwashing was <u>62873</u> gallons
- Glen Oaks Rd. relocating meter
- Ammonia/Zinc

A motion was made by Rodney DeRouen, duly seconded by Mrs. Quinn accepting the manager report for the water plant. Motion carried unanimously.
