Meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM by Mr. Malcolm Franks. The roll was called and there was a quorum to conduct business.

Ms. Arlene Zito addressed the board on her concern of a high water bill for the month of April. She was presented with a snap shot of the meter usage for her meter.

The Agenda was amended with a *motion made by Geri Alford, second by Megan Quinn to add Mr. Steinke for the presentation of the* 2^{nd} quarter financial report and Executive session item. Motion carried.

<u>A motion was made by Ms. Megan Quinn, seconded by Ms. Geri Alford approving the transfer of \$80,000 dollars from the</u> <u>Contingency Fund to Water Revenue Fund to meet financial obligations for the month, motion carried unanimously.</u>

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Gary Steinke with Steinke & Associates presented the 2nd quarter financial. <u>*The financial report was approved on a motion by Geri</u></u><u>Alford, second by Megan Quinn, motion carried.</u></u>*

The Minutes of the April 12, 2016 meeting were brought to floor for approval. <u>A motion to approve the minutes of the April 12th</u> meeting was made by Ms. Megan Quinn, second by Ms. Geri Alford, motion carried.

Treasurer's report was presented by Geri Alford, Treasurer. Checks written for the month of April were #013211 THRU #013234. <u>A</u> motion to approve the Treasurer's report for April 2016 was made by Megan Quinn, second by Geri Alford, motion carried.

<u>A motion was made by Megan Quinn, seconded by Ms. Geri Alford authorizing board president to proceed with the C.W.E.F.</u> <u>application for variable frequency drive, motion carried.</u>

USDA requested a copy of the Water Revenue account. Admin Secretary will send the statement on a monthly basis via email to USDA per request for review of funding.

<u>A motion was made by Ms. Megan Quinn, seconded by Ms. Geri Alford naming Malcom Franks as the Louisiana Public Assistant</u> Designee, motion carried.

The board reviewed to price increase for meters on new service requests. <u>A motion was made by Ms. Geri Alford, second by Ms. Megan</u> <u>Quinn to increase the meter installation to \$850.00, motion carried.</u>

Rick Leonard presented the Manager report for April 2016 to the Board:

- Plant usage for backwashing was 86,603 gallons
