### Minutes of South Toledo Bend Water Board March 13, 2017

Board Members Present: Malcolm Franks, Robert Marshall, Geri Alford, Megan Quinn, Rodney DeRouen

Others Present: Richard Leonard (Plant manager), Gary Steinke (Steinke & Associates)

Meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM by Malcolm Franks. The roll was called and there was a quorum to conduct business.

A motion was made by Geri Alford to adopt the Agenda, second by Rodney DeRouen, all agreed, motion carried.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

The Minutes of the February 13, 2017 meeting were brought to the floor for approval. A motion to approve the minutes of the February 13th meeting was made by Megan Quinn, second by Rodney DeRouen, approved by all, motion carried.

Treasurer's report was presented. Checks written for the month of February were #013457 THRU #013484. A motion to approve the Treasurer's report for February 2017 was made by Robert Marshall, second by Rodney DeRouen, agreed by all, motion carried.

A motion was made by Megan Quinn to pay the bills as presented, duly seconded by Robert Marshall, all agreed, motion carried.

A motion was made to change the way payments are made to AT&T and Hughes Net. A motion was made by Robert Marshall to have the payments made by auto withdrawal from the bank, second by Rodney DeRouen, agreed by all, motion passed unanimously.

FEMA: The finance review was completed on March 1st and the paperwork was sent over so that a check could be mailed to us.

The quarterly financial statement was presented by Gary Steinke. A motion was made by Geri Alford to approve the quarterly financial report, second by Robert Marshall, approved by all, passed unanimously.

There was a discussion on the current water rates. Mr. Franks asked Mr. Steinke if he would help us come up with a number for a possible rate increase and informed him that we are currently working with the LRWA on this matter.

All Board members have completed their Ethics training.

There was a brief discussion as to when the new truck would arrive and the repairs to truck #25. The board agreed to table this discussion until the April board meeting.

Rick Leonard presented the Manager report for February 2017 to the Board:

- All monthly State reports and samples sent to LADHH.
- Plant processed 5,605,000 gals of water @ an average of 175,516 gallons per day and shipped out 5,365,363 gals. of water @ an averaging of 173.076 gals, per day
- Plant usage for production (chlorine, caustic, & polymer carrier waters) estimated @ 50,000 gallons.
- Plant usage for backwashing was 75,637 gallons
- HACH contract
- Sanitary Survey
- Integralert
- Hydro tank (main plant)

A motion to renew the HACH contract was made by Geri Alford, second by Robert Marshall, all agreed, motion passed unanimously.

Sanitary Survey: This is scheduled to be done around the 21st of the month.

The board was informed that half of the Integralert is not working due to AT&T making changes to their system. Mr. Franks and Mr. Marshall will work on resolving this issue.

A motion to accept the Manager/Operator report as presented was made by Robert Marshall, second by Geri Alford., all agreed, motion carried.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Dess Road project: waiting for engineers to complete the designs.

CWEF Update.

Ground Storage Tanks: We want to get this done before the weather gets too hot.

There was no other business and a motion to adjourn was made by Robert Marshall, second by Geri Alford, agreed by all, motion carried.
