Meeting was called to order at 5:00 PM by Malcolm Franks. A prayer was said. The roll was called and there was a quorum to conduct business.

The resolution has been adopted and passed by all board members.

A motion to enter Executive Session was made by Mike Walker, 2nd by Tim Collins, all agreed, motion passed. A motion to come out of Executive Session, where no motions or actions were taken, was made by Mike Walker, 2nd by Rodney DeRouen, all agreed, motion passed.

Rick Leonard presented the Manager report for August 2019 to the Board:

- All monthly State reports and samples sent to LADHH.
- Plant processed 7,158,000 gals of water @ an average of 230,903 gals. per day and shipped out 7,073,914 gals. of water @ an averaging of 228,190 gals. per day
- Plant usage for production (chlorine, caustic, & polymer carrier waters) estimated @ 50,000 gallons.
- Plant usage for backwashing was 84,086 gallons.
- Enforcement survey
- Water loss
- Mail out (chlorine residuals)
