## Minutes of South Toledo Bend Water Board November 12, 2020

Board Members Present: Malcolm Franks, Rodney DeRouen, Anna Ferguson Absent: Michael Walker, Tim Collins Others Present: Rick Leonard (superintendent)

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by Malcolm Franks. A prayer was said, the roll was called and there was a quorum to conduct business.

## A motion to adopt the agenda was made by Anna Ferguson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Rodney DeRouen, motion passed.

Public comment: Mr. Mike Allen (owner of Toledo Bend Marina) was present to ask if he could get some assistance on a high water bill, he felt was due to the hurricane. He was shown a data log which was done on his meter and showed the leak occurred around September 6-7. This was well after the hurricane. It was explained to Mr. Allen that due to the Louisiana laws and guidelines we could not adjust the bill. He understood that we all have to follow rules and was glad he found the leak when he did, or the bill could have been higher. He thanked the board for listening to him and left.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

The minutes of the October 8th meeting were brought to the floor for approval. <u>A motion to approve the minutes of the</u> October meeting was made by Rodney DeRouen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Anna Ferguson, motion passed.

The treasurer's report for October was presented by Anna Ferguson. Checks written for the month of October were #014649 thru #014682. Board members were presented with an itemization of the credit card charges and a bank balance sheet. <u>A motion to approve the treasurer's report for October was made by Rodney DeRouen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Anna Ferguson, motion passed.</u>

## A motion to authorize payment of the bills was made by Malcolm Franks, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Rodney DeRouen, motion passed.

Board member commission renewal: Malcolm stated that he had spoken with both Tim & Mike, previously by phone, and that both would like Anna to stay with the board. - For the month of October, the plant processed 6,550,000 gals of water @ an average of 211,290 gals. per day and shipped out 6,483,953 gals. of water @ an averaging of 209,159 gals. per day
- Plant usage for production (chlorine, caustic, & polymer carrier waters) estimated @ 50,000 gallons.
- Plant usage for backwashing was 66,047 gallons.
